WHY SHOULD I PLEDGE?

By making a pledge, you become a participant in building bridges here at FPC and the Thomasville community. As family we share life and ministry together in the spiritual as well as the physical world. This year, plan on joining the 40% of your church family who made a pledge last year.

HOW MANY PEOPLE WILL SEE/KNOW MY PLEDGE?

Only one. Our Church Administrator is the **only** person that sees and records pledges. All pledges and tithes are completely confidential.

HOW DO I PLEDGE?

We have created three easy options for you to make your pledge:

- You can pledge on our website by visiting fpcthomasville.com/stewardship2024 and fill out our online pledge form.
- You may use the QR code found on the Pledge Card by using your smart phone.
- Fill out the Pledge Card, place in the security envelope provided and bring to the service on Sunday, November 12th.

We ask that you bring your filled out pledge card and envelope with you on Sunday, November 12, 2023.

WHAT HAPPENS ON COMMITMENT SUNDAY?

On Commitment Sunday during the last hymn of the Arise and Traditional services, the congregation will have the opportunity to come forward row by row to place their pledge card in a basket as an act of worship. If you pledge online, we welcome you to participate as well by filling in your name and checking the "I already pledged online" box on the physical pledge card.
